CLEMSON OVERVIEW

- Clemson, which has a 7-0 home record, defeated USC Upstate (7-0) and Presbyterian (11-2) in midweek games.
- The Tigers are averaging 8.4 runs per game and hitting .293 with a .456 slugging percentage, .428 on-base percentage and 17 steals.

- The pitching staff has a 3.90 ERA, .215 opponents' batting average and 3.17 strikeout-to-walk ratio, and Clemson is fielding .978.

DAVIDSON OVERVIEW

- Davidson, which has an 0-2 road record and is averaging 6.0 runs per game, is led by seventh-year Head Coach Rucker Taylor.
- The Wildcats lost at South Carolina 7-3 on Tuesday. They are hitting .266 and have a 6.26 ERA and .962 fielding percentage.
- Jamie Daly is hitting .395 with three homers and 11 RBIs, and Jack Cotrone is batting .361 with two homers and 11 RBIs.

QUICK HITS

- Clemson is on a 10-game winning streak, its longest streak since its 11-game winning streak from Feb. 24 to March 13 in 2024.
- Clemson's highest-scoring inning is the ninth, when it has outscored its opponents 19-0. Clemson has only batted four times in the ninth.
- Clemson's bullpen has a 9-0 record, six saves, a 3.71 ERA, .220 opponents' batting average and 73 strikeouts in 63.0 innings pitched.

POLLS

- Clemson is ranked as high as No. 4 in the nation by Perfect Game this week.
- Clemson was ranked in the top 10 of at least one poll in all 18 weeks in 2024. It has a current streak of 22 top-10 rankings in a row.
- Clemson has a current 30-week streak of being ranked in the top 25 of at least one poll dating to the 2023 season.
- The Tigers have been ranked in at least one weekly poll every year since 1987, when Clemson began tracking weekly polls.

DOUG KINGSMORE STADIUM



Doug Kingsmore Stadium, the home of Tiger baseball since 1970, has seen many changes and improvements over the years, but it has not lost its aesthetic beauty and unique feel on the west side of the Clemson University campus.

Doug Kingsmore Stadium has over 4,500 permanent seats, but is capable of holding 6,272 fans thanks to a hill area down the left-field line that is popular with students.

The park features a terrace in the outfield adjacent to the fence, similar to the old Crosley Field in Cincinnati. Former Head Coach Bill Wilhelm liked the look and practicality of a field with grass around the outfield instead of gravel or dirt.

In 2015, a three-story building was constructed behind the first-base dugout. It houses a state-of-the-art clubhouse, coaches offices and a player lounge among other amenities.

ATTENDANCE

- Clemson is averaging 5,073 fans per home date (7), the 10th-highest figure in the nation and second in the ACC (through games of March 5).
- In a 5-3 win over South Carolina on Feb. 28, Clemson set a school record with 6,891 fans in attendance at Doug Kingsmore Stadium.
- Entering 2025, Clemson had a top-20 national figure in average home attendance for 31 straight seasons.

SHRINERS SHOWDOWN RECAP

- Clemson was one of four teams in the six-team Shriners Children's College Showdown with a 2-1 record to tie for the best record.
- The showdown at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas from Feb. 14-16 marked Clemson's first three games in an MLB stadium and a dome.
- It marked Clemson's first regular-season game outside the Eastern time zone since 2005.
- Clemson defeated No. 13 Oklahoma State 6-5 in the first game, then beat No. 12 Arizona 16-5 in its second game before falling to Ole Miss.
- Oklahoma State and Arizona were the top-two teams, respectively, in the Big 12 Conference coaches pre-season poll.
- The Tigers hit .324 with 10 doubles, 27 runs, a .418 on-base percentage, two steals and a .990 fielding percentage in the showdown.
- Dominic Listi was 5-for-9 (.556) with seven RBIs, four runs, two walks, two hit-by-pitches and a .643 on-base percentage in three games.

TIGERS SWEEP RIVAL GAMECOCKS

- Clemson swept South Carolina in three games at three different sites by a combined score of 18-6 from Feb. 28 to March 2.
- The Tigers won 5-3 at Clemson, 5-1 at Fluor Field in Greenville, S.C. and 8-2 at South Carolina.
- Clemson never trailed in the series.
- Clemson had a 1.69 ERA, .160 opponents' batting average and 36 strikeouts against nine walks in 27.0 innings pitched in the series.
- A Doug Kingsmore Stadium record crowd of 6,891 saw the Tigers outlast the Gamecocks 5-3 on Feb. 28.
- Ethan Darden received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series.
- Darden pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts to earn the win on March 1.
- Jarren Purify was 4-for-8 with a homer, double, three RBIs, a .636 on-base percentage and two steals in three games.
- It marked the third time in four years the Tigers swept South Carolina, as they won all three games in 2022 and both games in 2024.
- It upped Clemson's winning streak in the series to five, while the Tigers have won 10 of the last 12 meetings.
- Clemson has won eight of the last 11 series dating to 2015.

CAPTAINS

- Andrew Ciufu, Jacob Jarrell, Aidan Knaak and Jarren Purify were voted team co-captains.
- Jarrell was voted a team co-captain for the second time in his career, as he was a team co-captain in 2024.
- Seven Tigers were voted to the leadership council (assistant captains).
- Those seven Tigers are Joe Allen, Tristan Bissetta, Cam Cannarella, Dominic Listi, Lucas Mahlstedt, Tryston McCladdie and Josh Paino.

DARDEN HAVING HIS BEST SEASON

- Junior lefthander Ethan Darden is having his best season as a Tiger.
- A majority of his appearances each of his three seasons as a Tiger have been in a starting role.
- He is 2-0 with a 1.06 ERA, .183 opponents' batting average and 15 strikeouts against six walks in 17.0 innings pitched in 2025.
- He has not allowed a home run in his three appearances, all starts.
- Clemson has a 3-0 record in his three starts.
- He is holding opponents to .143 with runners on base and .125 with two outs.
- He has not allowed a steal and has 21 groundball outs compared to 10 flyball outs.
- He pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with six strikeouts to earn the win in Clemson's 5-1 win over South Carolina on March 1.
- He earned ACC Pitcher-of-the-Week honors and received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the series against South Carolina.
- In his career, he is 10-7 with a 4.79 ERA, .271 opponents' batting average and 102 strikeouts in 139.0 innings pitched over 41 appearances.

LISTI'S LISTS

- Senior and transfer outfielder Dominic Listi has become the starter in left field and leadoff batter while bringing energy to the team.
- He is hitting .405 with four doubles, 15 RBIs, 15 runs, 11 walks, six hit-by-pitches and a .567 on-base percentage in 13 games.
- He is the only Tiger to start all 13 games.
- He has hit safely in all 12 games he has made a plate appearance as a Tiger.
- He has only struck out six times.
- He is hitting .524 with runners on base and .556 with runners in scoring position.
- He is in his sixth year of college and has started all 216 of his teams' games during those six seasons.

MAHLSTEDT SOLID ON & OFF THE FIELD

- Senior and sidearm righthander Lucas Mahlstedt has been one of the team's best relievers since transferring to Clemson for the 2024 season.
- He is 0-0 with three saves, a 1.04 ERA, .167 opponents' batting average and 11 strikeouts against no walks in 8.2 innings pitched in 2025.
- He is holding opponents to 0-for-8 with two outs in 2025.
